To recap, my response was it all depends on the locked in interest rate and final terms but could be on the high end approximately \$50,000 per year.

Below is a response from the City's financial advisor, David Trageser, with D.A. Davidson. He wrote an estimated \$40,000 per year, depending on the rating.
