<b>Project Name</b>	<b>Shoreline Master Program Update</b>
<b>Proposal</b>	Pursuant to RCW 90.58 and WAC 173-26, Part III, the City is completing the Comprehensive Update to the City of Blaine Shoreline Master Program. This effort is being combined with the Periodic Update (RCW 90.58.080(4)). This combined effort will bring the City's Shoreline Master Program up-to-date with state statutes and best available science.
<b>Applicability</b>	All shoreline areas within the corporate limits of the City of Blaine. Shoreline jurisdiction including the water areas of Drayton Harbor, Semiahmoo Bay and Dakota Creek, together with the lands underlying them, plus those lands within 200 feet of the ordinary high water mark including wetlands associated with these water bodies.
<b>Environmental Review</b>	A Determination of Non-Significance has been released for the project and is available upon request from the Community Development Services Department.
<b>Comment Period</b>	The public comment period runs from May 28 <sup>th</sup> to June 27 <sup>th</sup> , 2019.
<b>Public Hearing Time and Location</b>	Members of the public will have an opportunity to comment on the proposal at a public hearing before the Blaine Planning Commission on June 27, 2019 at 7:00pm in the City Council Chambers at the Blaine City Hall located at 435 Martin Street, Suite 4000, Blaine, Washington, 98230.
