Just want to let you know that the D Street closure is due to a break in the CBP fiber optic cable that was caused by our contractor on the East Blaine sewer project. CBP needs the cable repaired ASAP so we have developed a plan to expedite repair. It involves leaving a ditch open overnight. This results in the road closure.

No one is blocked from accessing their property, and CBP will have agents on site to monitor the open trench because pedestrians may walk that area even with the road closed.
