RESOLUTION NO. 1899-22

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLAINE,
WASHINGTON, DECLARING CERTAIN CITY PROPERTY AS SURPLUS**

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the City has no further use of certain equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may determine that the equipment is surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the fair market value is determined for the surplus property; and

WHEREAS, if any of the items can be sold, at time of sale monies will be allocated back to the appropriate fund/department; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager or his designee will oversee the sale of the property or other method of disposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Blaine, Washington, declares a 1992 Hyster Forklift as surplus and the property approximate total value of \$1,500. The City declares miscellaneous computer and cell phones as surplus and will destroy them.
