Background/Summary:

On November 22, 2021, the Blaine City Council passed Ordinance 21-2971, adopting the budget for fiscal year 2022.

Ordinance 22-2987 is an amendment to the 2022 budget to adjust projected expenditures in the General Fund, General Government Capital Improvement Fund and Transportation Improvement Fund to add the Yew Avenue Restoration Project.

The funds being affected by the mid-year budget amendment are below:

General Fund – 001

This amendment also provides additional funds to the Demolition of Old City Hall. The actual costs were more than the original budget

General Government Capital Improvement - 307

This amendment increases the original budget for the Demolition of Old City Hall.

Transportation Capital Improvement - 333

This amendment establishes a budget for the Yew Avenue Restoration Project.

Budget Implications: Current Budget New Budget Request Non-Budgetary

If passed, this ordinance will increase the overall City budget in several different funds.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLAINE, WASHINGTON,
AMENDING THE 2022 BUDGET FOR GENERAL FUND 001, GENERAL GOVERNMENT CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT 307 AND TRANSPORTION FUND 333**

WHEREAS, the 2022 Budget was passed and accepted by the City Council on November 22, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, the Capital Improvement Plan is part of the approved 2022 Budget; and,

WHEREAS, was amendment on June 27, 2022, Ordinance 22-2983; and,

WHEREAS, some City funds have unanticipated expenditures; and,

WHEREAS, these City funds have sufficient revenues to cover the expenditures.
