*We recognize the critical role that accessible housing plays in creating a healthy and thriving community. Every year our city welcomes an average of 100 new residents. Assessing our needs helps us plan for and encourage the development of a variety of housing options for people of all incomes.*

### What is a Housing Action Plan?

A Housing Action Plan, or a HAP, is a policy document and implementation guide for the city to help us plan for and support new housing over the next 20 years. Washington state law requires that HAP strategies encourage construction of a greater variety of housing types and housing at prices that are accessible to people with a wide range of incomes. Once complete, the HAP will help guide decisions we make regarding changes to city policies that shape our housing landscape, including zoning laws, permitting processes, lot size requirements, and the sizes and types of housing we encourage.
